## 2025 Regular Tournament Rules

- 1. The Fishing Tournament will start at 6:00am Saturday, July 19, 2025 and ends at 3:00 pm on Sunday, July 27, 2025. Weigh station and scales will be open from noon till 2:00pm, and from6:00pm till 9:00pm each day. Persons with fish to weigh on any given day must be in line for the weigh station no later than 9:00pm each day, (Except Sunday, July 27th). Registration trailer will open on Thursday, July 17th at noon and close at 6:00pm and will also be open Friday, July 18th from noon until 9:00pm.
- 2. Each person seventeen (17) years of age and older on board must be registered. (Those under 17 may register for "Kid's Fishing Tournament" see separate rules) To be eligible for any tournament prize, persons must be registered, no matter the age. All registrants shall carry their registration card at all times. Cards are nontransferable. All boats are subject to "card check". Entry fee is \$90.00 per person for the regular tournament. Flags will be issued to the fishermen and fisherwomen this year thanks to sponsorships from Meridian Contracting. EXCEPTION: one-day pass available, \$25.00 Unlimited Individual no hat given. (Issued at registration trailer).
- 3. Each entrant upon registering to compete in the festival agrees to hold the sponsors; their agents; volunteers; or employees harmless from any liability of any nature and kind, for any injuries and/or damage suffered by the entrants during the period that the festival is being held.
  - 4. Regarding the fish and transportation of the fish:
- a). All Trout, Salmon, and Walleye must be caught in Lake Huron. Rivers or streams are NOT considered legal fishing waters, except the Thunder Bay River from the 2nd Ave. bridge to Lake Huron. There are no boundaries for north and south this year, all U.S. waters of Lake Huron (with the exception of the Lake Trout Refuges) are legal to fish in the regular 9 day tournament. The following situations apply to this "NO" boundary rule:
- 1. No tournament boat can come in contact with any land or ports except Presque Isle Harbor or Alpena City Boat Harbor.
- 2. No extra gasoline cans can be carried on board during any Michigan Brown Trout Festival Tournaments.
- 3. NOTE: NO FISHING IS ALLOWED IN THE LAKE TROUT REFUGES MAPS AVAILABLE AT THE REGISTRATION TRAILER.
- b). All fish must be transported to the official weigh-in station at the Alpena City Boat Harbor. Fishermen will also have the option of

checking fish at Presque Isle Harbor. There will be an official Brown representative Trout at Presque Isle Harbor from 11:00am to 1:00pm and 7:00pm to 8:00pm daily from Saturday, July 19th through Saturday, July 26th and Sunday, July 27th, 2025, from 11:00am to 1:00pm. Cooler must be presented at the Official Weigh Station within one hour of the time listed on the check in

slip given at Presque Isle Harbor.

- c). At Presque Isle Harbor, each angler presenting fish to weigh will have their registration card available for proof of participation in the tournament. The Brown Trout representative will verify the number of fish to be weighed, will seal each cooler and give fishermen a tag for transport to Alpena City Boat Harbor. The cooler MUST be sealed when presented at the Weigh Station in Alpena. Any fish transported from Presque Isle Harbor must be transported in a sealable fish cooler, NO fish bags or buckets are permitted and will lead to disqualification.
- d. Transfer of any items from boat to boat or physical contact with another boat will disqualify both boats for that day. In case of an extreme emergency situation, Tournament Control must be notified to determine if disqualification is required.
- 5. Each contestant is entitled to only one final prize in each division. With a maximum of two prizes per boat per division.
- 6. Winners will be determined by the weight of the fish. All fish entered must be whole and contain no foreign matter; no gaffed or snagged fish will be eligible for any prizes. Fish must be opened for inspection after weighing if it qualifies for a prize. First place fish in each division must be left on display until 9:00pm on the day caught to qualify for a prize. Failure to have fish inspected or displayed may cause disqualification. Any tallied, displayed fish remaining after 10:00pm will be disposed of by Brown Trout Officials.

7.\*Payouts awarded for Salmon, Lake Trout, Steelhead & Walleye Divisions for each species:

i. 1st Prize - \$2,500.00/ Plaque

ii. 2nd Prize - \$1,050.00/Plaque

iii. 3rd Prize - \$600.00/Plaque

iv. 4th Prize - \$350.00

v. 5th Prize - \$200.00

\*Based on a minimum of 325 entrants.

\*Payouts awarded for Brown Trout Division:

i. 1st Prize -\$4,000.00/Plaque

ii. 2nd Prize - \$2,400.00/Plaque

iii. 3rd Prize - \$1,200.00/Plague

iv. 4th Prize - \$800.00

v. 5th Prize - \$450.00

\*Based on a minimum of 325 entrants.

8. The decision of the Tournament Officials will be final in the event of a dispute or unsportsmanlike conduct. In case of ties, the first fish weighed-in will be declared the winner.

9. Each contestant agrees to abide by the MBTF official rules and State fishing regulations. Upon signing entry form, officials may request entrants to show proof of valid Michigan fishing license; any failure to observe any rule will result in disqualification. (Any and all disqualification decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis by Tournament Officials.)

- 10. All fish must be weighed-in and entered in the contest at the official weigh-in station at the Alpena Boat Harbor. All qualifying fish will be opened for inspection. NO EXCEPTIONS! Each fish weighed will be assigned a registration number. To protect our community Brown Trout plants, The Brown Trout Festival will impose a minimum size limit of 18 inches for Brown Trout caught during the tournament. Any Brown Trout weighed in that are under 18 inches will not be eligible for any prizes and there will be a penalty of \$15.00 enforced for a re-stocking fee.
- 11. All protests must be submitted on an official Protest Form. Forms are available at the Weigh-in Station/Tournament Trailer. A cash deposit of \$50.00 must accompany each protest. Protests will be accepted no later than noon the following day of each tournament day. If the protest is upheld, the deposit will be refunded. If not upheld, the deposit will become property of the Michigan Brown Trout Festival. All protests will be handled by a "protest committee" of at least three Tournament officials. Any social media post by individuals may disqualify themselves without a formal protest.
- 12. At the discretion of the Tournament Director, observers may be placed onboard any boat at any time during the 9 days of fishing. Tournament control monitors Channel 68.
- 13. Additional prize opportunities: The Largest Daily regulation fish weighed in for each of the five specified divisions will receive a \$50 Visa Gift Card from Wolverine State Credit Union and must be claimed by 7-27-2025 before 5:00pm.

The Tournament Committee will provide a colored flag and/ or boat identification number for each contestants boat. The flag shall be flown on the contestant's radio antenna in full view from all directions during the full 9 day tournament. Failure to display the flag at all times during the tournament can result in disqualification.

Excessive complaints and/or unsportsmanlike behavior at any time during the 9 day tournament will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification from the tournament and will not be allowed to participate in the future. All competitors upon registering with signature:

- 1. Agrees to abide by the policies, rules and decisions set forth by the Michigan Brown Trout Festival Coordinator(s) and MDNR regulations.
- 2. Agrees that competitors may be disqualified for any violation of tournament rules with no refund of entry fee. Decision of Tournament Director and officials is final.
- 3. Agrees that award recipients are responsible for payment of all taxes on prizes and a 1099 Misc will be issued for prizes of \$600 or more. You must submit a valid W-2 Form in the calendar year you win.

Refusal to submit proper social security information and current address will result in disqualification. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of any prize monies awarded.

4. Agrees that all photos, video or any other materials which may used for future promotion are property of the Michigan Brown Trout Festival.

Refunds: In the event of any cancellation of tournaments, refunds will be issued in the form of a check and mailed to the Captains within ten business days of the tournament ending. No Refunds on late fees.

Holding fish at the dock: Any potential board fish caught after the scales close on any given day of the tournament with the intention of weighing the fish the following day must be called into tournament control for verification and instructions. Fish held overnight will be counted for the day they were caught. Failure to due so will disqualify the fish from the tournament. This year there will be a 2 day Super Tournament sponsored by Amrize with a guaranteed \$10,000 first place (based on a 20 boat entry). Entry fee will be \$250 per team. There will be The Besser Company Jason Rensberry Amateur Shootout with a \$5,000 guarantee first place (based on 20 boat entry) sponsored by Besser. Entry fee will be \$150 per team, with no previous Super Tournament winners or charter boats allowed to fish. Only boats from 16' to 24' will be permitted. Also, there will be a Walleye Extravaganza sponsored by Coors Light with a guaranteed \$3,000 first place prize (based on 20 boat entry). Entry fee will be \$200 for a four person team.

Boundaries will be: Northern Boundary 45.12.000'N (Middle Island), Southern Boundary 44.50.000'N (Black River Island) Eastern Boundary 82.53.000'W.

Walleye will be excluded from the Ladies Classic, Amateur Shoot-Out and Super Tournament catches this year; However, there will still be a walleye division for largest of the tournament to participate in.

This year the city boat launch fees will not be waived during the 9 day tournament. A city launch permit or a daily launch fee will be required to launch. A special day launch permit will be available at the transient gas dock or the registration trailer for \$15.00 and will be good from 7/17/2025 to 7/27/2025.

Please make sure you have a valid address, phone number and proper MC numbers and boat names and valid Michigan fishing license when registering for the tournaments. Early registration starts on 7/17/2025 from 12:00 - 6:00pm and 7/19/2025 12:00 - 9:00pm at the registration trailer.

Presque Isle Harbor will be open all nine days for cooler checks with designated checks twice daily; except for the last Sunday. There will be no cooler checks at Rockport, therefore no fish will be accepted from this harbor and will be automatically disqualified from the tournament.

The daily merchandise package will be back this year for a chance to win a daily package valued @ \$100.00 each.

All fishermen fishing the 3-day High Stakes Tournament must leave & return daily to the port of Alpena, no overnight anchoring.

When weighing in fish at the official weigh station there must be a valid MBTF registration card holder present for each legal MDNR daily limit of fish (no exceptions). Every fish weighed in throughout the festival will get a ticket for a chance to win a \$250.00 Visa card drawn on 7/27/2025. All daily big fish payouts will be a \$50.00 Visa gift card sponsored by Wolverine State Credit Union and must be claimed by 7/27/2025 by 5:00pm (otherwise they are forfeited).

A progressive pot (bounty) for specially tagged "Big Brownies" will be building this year to over \$5500.00 for the first one caught during the festival.

All fish caught during the Ladies Classic, Three Day High Stakes Amateur Shoot-Out and Super Tournament, and all qualified board fish will be opened up for inspection.



2025 MBTF 5th Annual Youth Offshore Tournament Wednesday, July 23rd, 2025 from 6:00am - 3:00pm for youth 12 -16 years of age. Registration deadline Monday, July 21st by 9:00pm. Captains meeting Tuesday, July 22, after 6:00pm.

This tournament is an offshore boat fishing tournament for youth to catch and weigh Walleye, Trout and Salmon. Prizes awarded for heaviest cooler and largest fish caught by weight.

This year there will be two divisions, one for Trout/Salmon and for Walleye. Each division will have prizes for the heaviest cooler and heaviest fish. Heaviest cooler based on one person Michigan DNR daily limit for Trout/Salmon & Walleye. Walleye won't count in the Trout/Salmon category for weight. Entry fee: \$25.00 per fisherperson. Adults are not required to be registered and are not allowed to fish. Each fisherperson is allowed 3 lines each and must catch all of their own fish. The adults will be allowed to net all fish for safety reasons.

Limit teams to a maximum of 4 youth per boat. Weigh in will be at the MBTF scales starting at 3:00pm sharp. No late coolers will be accepted. Results will be posted the following day. Awards and prizes will be handed out on Sunday, July 27th, 2025 starting at 5:00pm.

Prizes are awarded for the total weight of the 10 heaviest fish (a 2 person M-DNR limit). No more than 10 fish will be allowed in a cooler at the time of cooler being sealed and placed in line for weigh in. More than 10 fish in a cooler will disqualify the team. Three additional people are allowed on board only to set lines, navigate, and assist in clearing lines. 


